

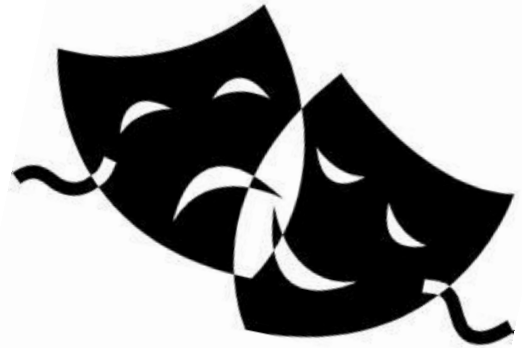
# IMPACT SHOWCASE

---

We are so excited to have your student(s) perform in the *Impact Showcase!* Thank you for submitting a number and for preparing your students for this experience.

As a reminder: this showcase will be performed in the Harris Fine Arts Center on Thursday afternoon. The conference participants will be split up into two performance spaces (the deJong Concert Hall and the Pardoe Theater) and each venue will see the entire showcase. We will begin the showcase in one venue at number one on the running list and begin the showcase in the other venue at number ten on the running list running all the way through number nine. So each performing piece will be able to perform twice – once on each stage – and every conference participant will see the whole show.

- ❖ Keep in mind that this showcase is to perform for secondary students, so please be sensitive in the content of your piece. Also, being a church-owned university, BYU has very high standards and expectations for theatre pieces. Questionable, inappropriate content will not be allowed to perform on its stages. Please carefully review your piece to ensure its appropriateness and quality. Numbers that do not fit BYU standards will not be allowed to perform in the showcase.



Here is what you need to remember in terms of the performance spaces and technical options:

- ❖ The time limit on each performance piece: 4-5 minutes maximum.
- ❖ If you must use any musical accompaniment or have other music needs, the only acceptable means of playing the music will be minus track/CD. Your musical number must be the only track on the CD; 2 CD's will be needed – one for each venue.
- ❖ There will be a dance floor down in the deJong, so no sharp shoes or other objects will be allowed in any performance pieces.
- ❖ The performing area will be limited to a 20' (deep) x 30' (wide) space.
- ❖ The only set pieces allowed for the showcase will be black blocks provided by BYU in each space.
- ❖ There will be basic lighting washing areas of the stage.
- ❖ If you are using a mic: your actor(s) will need to wear a belt to clip the mic pack onto or bring their own mic belt pack.
- ❖ The “costume dress” for the showcase performers will be denim and the conference t-shirt. Personal character accessories are allowed.
- ❖ If you must have props for your performance piece (beyond black blocks) please only use minimal props. There will be no room to store any props backstage.
- ❖ Your assigned run-through time (if you asked for one) will occur first in the Pardoe Theatre and then move to the deJong Concert Hall immediately afterwards. Be at the Pardoe Theatre – tunnel entrance onto backstage – at least ten minutes early to ensure your time on the stage.
